## Directions to the Emeriti/Retirees Relations Center (ERRC)

If you have a UCLA parking permit (Retiree Blue or Emeriti), you may park on Levels 1-5 of Parking Structure 5 (P5). If you are a UCLA retiree and do not currently have a parking permit, you can purchase a permit or obtain a Ridecard prior to the day you plan to visit.

- **Retiree/emeriti parking permit**—retirees with at least 20 years of service credit may purchase a Retiree Blue or Emeriti permit by contacting the ERRC. The ERRC will verify your eligibility with the parking office; you can then visit the office Monday Friday to purchase a permit.
- **Retiree/emeriti Ridecard**—for retirees with less than 20 years of service credit, or those who visit the campus only occasionally, the most cost-effective option is a complimentary Ridecard, which allows you to purchase a daily permit at a discounted rate (currently \$6). With a Ridecard, each time you visit the campus you must first stop at a parking kiosk\* to purchase a daily permit before proceeding to your preferred parking area.

If you are not eligible or do not wish to purchase a permit or obtain a Ridecard, you may:

- Purchase a daily pass (currently \$13/day) at a parking kiosk.
- With a disabled placard, purchase a daily permit for \$11 per day at a parking kiosk.
- \* The closest parking kiosks to Rolfe Hall are located next to the Faculty Center, near Westholme/Hilgard, or near the John Wooden Center, on Westwood Plaza off Sunset.
