Emeriti and Staff Retiree Parking Permit & Daily Discounted ePermit Instructions 2024-2025

Emeriti/Retirees Process:

- 1. Customer contacts UCLA Emeriti/Retirees Relations Center (ERRC) at (310) 825-7456 or emeriti@errc.ucla.edu to begin the process.
- 2. ERRC submits online paperwork to Transportation Services with the customer's information and the product they would like annual parking permit or daily discounted ePermit (formerly known as ridecard).
 - If customer chooses the daily discounted ePermit option, the emeriti/retiree will pay the discounted rate for parking on the ePermit portal before each visit to campus.
 - If customer chooses the annual parking permit option, they will pay for the permit on the <u>ePermit portal</u>.
 - Eligibility is based on years of service, except for emeriti permits that are offered to members of Academic Senate.
 - For assistance with the ePermit portal system, call UCLA Transportation Services at (310) 794-7433.

*Due to a California Supreme Court ruling, UCLA will be required to begin collecting a 10% Parking Occupancy Tax on behalf of the City of Los Angeles effective January 1, 2023. Prices below reflect the added tax.

Donors/Emeriti/V Blue Permit Holders who have Medical Appointments:

Following are the rules and conditions to be adhered to enjoy this privilege:

- May cross-park in (JS) Jules Stein or (MP) Medical Plaza except: 1, 8, 9, and 18 Yellow permit holders
- Valid for up to 3 hours once per day Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. only.
- Faculty and Staff must pay full price all day on weekends, and between the hours of 7:00p.m. to 8:00a.m. Monday Friday
- Cross-park privilege can only be used at the exit column, in lane, and cannot be used at any Pay-on-Foot (POF) pay station:
 - o At exit column, insert the entrance ticket you pulled into the exit column
 - o Depress the "help" button and state you are utilizing the cross-park privilege
 - You will need one of the two following pieces of information readily available and if you do not have this
 information, you will have to pay the prevailing:
 - 1. The license plate of the vehicle you are driving (license plate must be registered to a Bruin ePermit), or
 - 2. Your Bruin ePermit guest logon primary ID or your university ID (UID)
- Night or Weekend Permits must pay the prevailing daily rate
- One (1) day permits purchased via Bruin ePermit or campus pay stations are not eligible
